Medicine and care of the dying: A modern history

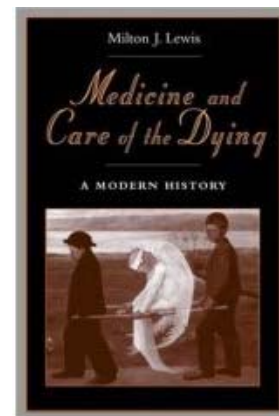
